

## **NARRATIVE PROFILE: ENGR. JUN PAUL U. MISTICA**

Engr. Jun Paul U. Mistica has been working for the government, particularly the LLDA, for more than three decades already. During those years, he assumed various responsibilities concerning shoreland and aquaculture management, environmental compliance of industries, and different aspects of project cycle management.
